

## MODX Connect V1.0.6 for Windows Release Notes

### Main Revisions and Enhancements

#### V1.0.4 -> V1.0.6

- Now supports Cubase 10 series.
- Fixed some minor problems.

### Minimum System Requirements

- Note that the system requirements may be slightly different from those described below depending on the particular computer.
- Keep in mind that the software is often updated and the system requirements are subject to change. You can check the latest version information of each program and its system requirements at the following website:

OS	Windows 7 SP1 / Windows 8.1 Update / Windows 10 (64-bit only)*
DAW Application	Cubase 9 series / Cubase 10 series
Others	These system requirements conform to those of the DAW applications and OS.

\* Operation is not guaranteed in Windows XP mode on Windows 7 or in the Boot Camp partition on Mac OS X.

### Installing the application

1. After the downloaded compressed file is properly extracted, double-click a following file.  
Install MODX Connect.exe
2. Follow the on-screen instructions to install the software.

### For users of Windows 8.1

#### Starting the application:

Once the application is successfully installed, an icon of the application will be in your Windows 8.1 Start screen. You can start the application by clicking the icon.

#### NOTE

If the icon is not listed, click the downwards arrow at the bottom left in the Start Screen to list all applications. Then select the application icon from the application list.

## **Uninstalling the application:**

Use “Control Panel” to uninstall the software.

In Control Panel, click [Programs and functions] or [Uninstall a program], then select the item you want to uninstall, and click [Uninstall].

A dialog box will appear; follow the instructions in the screen to uninstall the software.

If the “User Account Control” dialog box appears, click [Continue] or [Yes].

The way to access Control Panel will depend on your operating system.

- Windows 7 users

Click [Start] → [Control Panel].

- Windows 8.1 users

Right click [Start] → [Control Panel].

- Windows 10 users

Right click [Start] → [Apps and Features]

Or

Click [Start] → [Settings] → [Apps]
